#### 4. Project Updates - Dan Chism BLE

- a. 2019 Resurfacing Contracts-
  - i. 106 is complete with the exception of thermal and rumble strips (2.1 million contract)
  - **ii.** 108 Kings started projects in Powdersville area and moving to Pelzer then Honea Path.
  - iii. 107 Estimated start date of September/October
- b. **Minor Street** Piles driven and deck slabs have been set. Completion estimated reopening for mid-September.
- c. **Big Water Rd** –Purchasing is working on bid documents. Projected to bid after Labor Day.
- d. **One Time Funding** \$938,149.00 Airline/Beckman and George Albert Lake in the 107 contract will use \$666,077.96 leaving a balance of \$272,071.04
- e. Levis Smith Rd One time funding using Hot-in-place recycling proposed balance above (\$272,071.04). Cutler Resurfacing awarded contract. Needs additional \$100,000.00 of funds this year. Motion Grayson Kelly, second Charlie Wham, unanimously approved both the road change from Levis Smith to 6&20 and the additional \$100,000.00 funds.
- f. **City of Anderson Road List 2020**: \$880,000 originally approved BLE is preparing bid documents for the City of Anderson. Estimate is \$884,010.00 The city will cover the difference (Michael Gay). Anticipated bidding in November to allow a January 2020 award.
