


1. www.andersoncountysc.org


2. Andersoncountysc.org/assessor




3. Property Viewer


a. Click on the third logo from the left under the heading County Services and Requests.




b. From here it will open the address propertyviewer.andersoncountysc.org/mapsjs/




c. Searching the Property Viewer



d. Advanced Parcel Search




e. Sales Search

By clicking "Clear", you will clear the current search.


By clicking "Zoom To", the map will zoom to display all the data in the search

g. Controlling the layers on the map




You can turn on any of the layers listed by using the check box found to the left of the layer. To see all available layers use the scroll bar to navigate up and down.

h. Map tools




4. Public Access (ACPASS)



1. By clicking on "Assessor's Office", it will take you to the web page mentioned on page 2 of this document.


