- 1. Call to Order called to order by Chairman Townsend at 4:00 pm
- 2. Approval of Minutes
  - **a.** August 10, 2020– Motion by Glenn Stevens, second Tom Allen, approved minutes unanimously.
  - 3. SCDOT Annual Report Brittany Burdette
    - a. Review of Annual Report submitted to the SCDOT
      - i. Motion from James D Smith, second from Tom Allen to approve the submittal (after signed by the Chairman) of the report to the SCDOT, unanimously approved.
  - 4. Engineer Report Bryan Howard BLE
    - a. Project Updates
      - 1. One Time Funds (P117.135) Baugh Road (Contract 109)

Subcontractor mobilized to site on August 26, 2020 and repaired 2 locations in the road and replaced thermo white edge line in the patched location.

### **ACTC Minutes**

Greenville City has been notified and is releasing final pay estimate.

### Contract 110 - City of Anderson Roads

- Pickens Construction has milled and paved Kingsley Road at Anderson University.
- Fast dry paint has been completed on Kingsley. Remaining pay items include Thermo Striping, Shoulder Material (where applicable) and RPM's.
- Pickens has completed milling on Glenn Street. Paving to be completed the week of September 21<sup>st</sup>.
  - An issue came up on Glenn St. While milling steel railroad tracks were discovered passing under the existing roadway. Karen Dent gave permission per a change order for Pickens to cut the tracks and remove along with the existing cross ties. The area is 14' x 24'. Once tracks and rails are removed the area will be patched with Intermediate C asphalt. This will be before paving of the surface course. A change order has been sent to Pickens for signature and once returned will be sent to Brittany and Holt for signatures.
- Variable milling and full depth patching has started on Revere St.

### Contract 111 - Town of Williamston

- All streets have been patched and paved except for Mattison Street
- Paved streets still need to be striped, RPM's installed, and shoulders backfilled where applicable

### Contract 112 - Town of Pelzer Roads

- All streets have been patched and paved
- Paved streets still need to be striped, RPM's installed, and shoulders backfilled where applicable

### Contract 113 - Town of Belton Roads

- Milling and patching has been performed on Smythe Street
  - There are some subgrade issues that are causing issues with the patching that has been performed. Bryan Howard met with John Van Patton of Rogers Group and a solution has been finalized. Waiting on pricing from Contractor to do a change order.
- Milling and full depth patching is completed on Broyles Ave, Cox Dr., and Mattison Dr.
- Mattison has be paved with remaining pay items being Striping, RPM's and shoulder material (where applicable)
- Broyles Ave and Cox Dr. will be paved and finished with the same remaining pay items, as above, by the end of the week of September 21st

### **Contract 114 - State Matching Roads**

- No field work has been performed for this contract
- We understand that Pickens Construction plans to complete Contract 110 prior to starting Contract 114.
