#### 3. New Business: Population Rosters

- Of the 128 Pre-Trial detainees (meeting detainment thresholds) to review, 88 felony/combination and 40 misdemeanor/violation of probation individuals were addressed by stakeholder group.
- Population Review Included: Days held, charge(s), bond amount, disciplinary action within the detention center, detention center classification, substance/DNA analysis status (if applicable), and cases status for both the Solicitor's and Public Defender's Office.
- Based on Review, 87 of the 128 individuals required active follow-up action to ensure efficient case processing/management:
  - 26 Solicitor's Office actions required.
  - 29 Public Defender's Office actions required.
  - 12 Forensic Division actions required.
  - 20 PPP actions required
- During this review, there was 1 misdemeanor/probation and 12 felony cases that exceeded the agreed upon time standard thresholds.
- Data demonstrates a positive reduction of misdemeanor/probation cases greater than 91 days from 8% of current population to 2%, successfully under the benchmark established by the stakeholders.

- Data demonstrates a positive reduction of felony/combination cases greater than 361 days from 14% of current population to 12% successfully under the benchmark established by the stakeholders. (Reference 5.16.19 Infographic)

## 4. New Business: Detention Center Facility Recommendations

- Increased attorney visit space. Video conferencing capabilities not necessary, as face-to-face is preferred.
- Dedicated space for programming and volunteer services.
- Bond court to be housed in the same complex for logistical and technical considerations.
