

Incidents, Arrests and Served Warrants
















Ages of Booked Inmates


Race: Females


Race: Males

** 2021 is a snippet of the year due to a new reporting system being implemented in May.




Race: Total

2021 Detention Center: Average Daily Population and Capacity




Average Daily Population 2021



Top 10 Offenses: 2019




Top 10 Offenses: 2020








Average Length of Stay




Military Service Report 2021



In the year of 2021, **eighty-two men** and **two women** who served in the military were booked into the Anderson County Detention Center.









Status of Mental Health Screenings in ACDC

Since the implementation on January 15, 2019, Universal Mental Health Screenings occur with every booking in the Anderson County Detention Center. The medical staff utilize the information for the inmates not released to coordinate care with the in-house doctor and/or local mental health facility. The Detention Center has a Mental Health Liaison assigned to the facility and we utilize TeleHealth (remote mental health sessions as needed).
