Floodplain Management is a county function and program of preventive and corrective measures to reduce the risk of current and future flooding, resulting in a more resilient community.

Flooding Risk is Real– Anywhere it rains, it can flood.

Know Your Risk– To reduce your flood risk, you need to know your level of risk. Click on the map below to check your property's flood risk.

Reduce Your Risk– Once you have learned your level of flood risk, you can work with your Floodplain Administrator to identify actions to reduce those risks.

Insure Your Risk– Another way to reduce flooding impacts is to purchase flood insurance through the NFIP.
