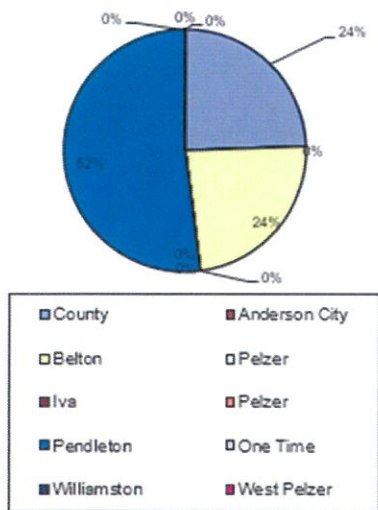

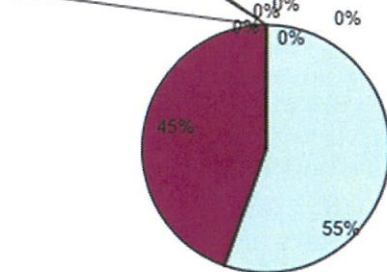

Engineer's Report

Update on Current Contracts

➤ ACTC 122 – Anderson County Roads

Substantial Completion issued on May 13, 2022. Warranty period is 1 year from that date.

➤ ACTC 124 – Pendleton Roads

Bids were accepted on October 27, 2022.

Only 1 bid – S&S Construction.

Bid was \$1,178,914.46, which was lower than the Engineer's estimate of \$1,536,418.00.

POSSIBLE COST SAVINGS - \$173,134

Preconstruction meeting was held on Dec. 20, 2022. Construction began Jan. 5, 2023

Clearing & Grubbing is complete, as is drainage. Weather has been a hold up and Town has a force main sewer that needs to be relocated.

Still anticipate contractor to beat completion date of June 30, 2023.

➤ ACTC 125 – SCDOT State Secondary Roads

Substantial Completion on October 13, 2022.

Final Estimate: \$2,919,848.31. (Estimate w/ contingency \$3,500,000)

ACTUAL COST SAVINGS - \$215,798.26

➤ ACTC 126 & 127 – Belton and District 6

Pickens has completed Belton work. Weather has prevented start of work in Powdersville.

Because of the wet weather, we issued a change order to delete full depth patching in favor of mill-in-place. Should let contractor get back to work quicker and **saves \$25,842.**

Completion date was extended to May 1, 2023.

ANTICIPATED COST SAVINGS – over \$200,000

➤ ACTC 128 – Evergreen

Preliminary Engineering Report does recommend improvements to Evergreen. Provided 3 options – 1. Widen to 3 lanes with sidewalks and crosswalk to the Y property line; 2. Option 1 plus bring rest of Evergreen up to current 2 lane standards; 3. Construct 3-lane for the entire length of Evergreen.

J. Bragg, SCDOT District 2 and Anderson County recommends Option 2.

Anticipated total cost for Option 2 is between \$3 and \$4M. Hard estimate won't be known until Engineering plans are completed at end of year. Design cost - \$285,000.00

ACTC 129 and 130 will be bid at the same time. We anticipate the bid will be advertised by early March.

- ACTC 131 – SCDOT State Secondary Roads – Bid package was given to Purchasing on Jan.5. We began contacting all contractors to let them know to be on the lookout for the bid request. **All contractors told us they would not bid the work!!** We had a Dec 31, 2023 completion date and they told us their Reclamation crews were tied up until fall of 2024. We pulled the bid on January 11. Discussed project with SCDOT District 2. It was decided to change roads with CMRB to roads with FDP and overlay. See list below.
