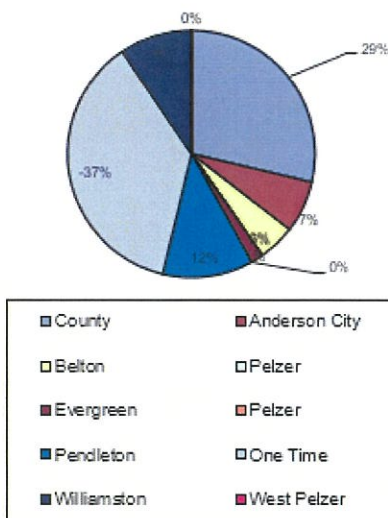

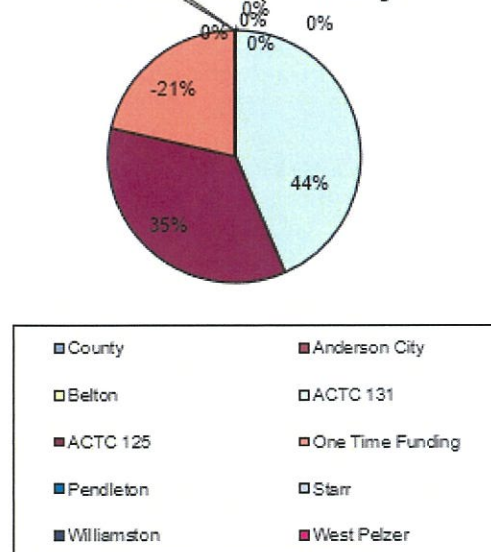

Update on Current Contracts

➤ ACTC 124 – Pendleton Roads

Anticipate project completion this week. Scheduled completion June 30.

➤ ACTC 126 & 127 – Belton and District 6

Project was completed on April 28. Completion date was May 1, 2023. Final Inspection scheduled for May 17.

➤ ACTC 128 – Evergreen

Preliminary Engineering Report was submitted. Design was authorized and will be completed. Survey and environmental have begun.

➤ ACTC 131 – State Secondary Roads

Bids were received on March 2.
