2. Old Business: By-Law Amendments

- Jennifer Johnson provided overview of By-Law edit for vote during Feb. meeting. (Expansion of Positional Leadership to include Information Technology)
- Casey Collins to email stakeholders edit ahead of Feb. meeting for review.

4. New Business: Mental Health and Super Utilizer Data

- Bobby Rettew presented Detention Center Mental Health referrals and Super Utilizer data overview. (Reference Related Documents).
- Michael Cunningham suggested sharing of information to overlay with AnMed's HER system to assist with identification and intervention.

5. New Business: Committee Updates

- Pre-Trial Risk Assessment
 - Casey Collins complete "live" assessments for individuals booked in the Detention Center on Dec. 27th and 28th, providing the assessment to Judge Malone both days.
 - Casey Collins attended bond hearings on the same above mentioned dates.
 - With the exception of one individuals, bond court conditions were in-line with assessments.
 - Judges provided feedback on usefulness and functionality, making form edit suggestions.
 - Committee will be meeting on Jan. 24th to review progress and discuss next steps.
 - Bond Court is public forum. Those wanting to attend are welcome.
- Mental Health/Veteran's Court
 - Mental Health/Veteran's Court discussion predate the formation of the CJCC.
 - Stakeholder group is seeking funding from private entity.
 - Judge Maddox and Solicitor Wagner are planning to make a presentation to County Council for resources prior to July.
 - Mental Health Court is approximately 2 months for opening its doors, with the Veteran's Court to follow 6-9 months behind that.
 - Mental Health will be moving its jurisdiction from Probate Court to Circuit Court.
- Crisis Stabilization Unit
 - During the Dec. meeting, committee members were provided a brief overview.
 - Committee will be meeting on Jan. 22nd to discuss the goal and purpose of this committee.
- Community Mapping
 - Seeking to expand the capability and functionality of the 2-1-1 system for information and service referrals.
 - Discussing the issue of community accessibility of an on-line and print format.
 - Discussing a detention center release- specific resource.
 - Committee will be meeting on Jan. 23rd to continue the above discussions and next steps.
- Community Engagement
 - Plan to embed two members of the Engagement Committee on the other committees to determine engagement needs. This will allow for a Community Engagement plan and timeline to be developed.
 - Pamela Christopher to provide names of embedded committee members joining other committees to ensure meeting invitations are extended.
- Detention Center Population Review Board
 - Review Board Infographic was presented. (Reference Related Documents)
 - Committee will be meeting on Jan. 30th to address action items from previous meeting and with a goal to complete a full-roster review.
