Dear Resident:

Thank you for your interest in speed humps for your neighborhood. The decision to install these devices must be carefully evaluated. Several issues to consider are increased response time of emergency vehicles, vehicle maintenance, and possible speeding between humps. Enclosed is the petition that must carry the signatures of 75% of the landowners in your subdivision.

The enclosed brochure will explain the criteria that must be met before a speed hump can be installed. Please read Section 2.4 *Funding*, in the Speed Hump Program brochure, which requires that the landowners pay 50% of the cost of the speed hump, prior to construction. Since speed humps are not budgeted items, it is necessary to require those residents who benefit from this device to help fund the installation. The cost of each speed hump is \$1000.00, of which residents will pay \$500.00 per speed hump.

Upon receipt of the signed petition with appropriate signatures, we will begin the process of evaluating your road for speed humps or other traffic calming devices. Once the evaluation is complete, our staff will meet with you to discuss the plan before installation. The process necessary from receipt of petition to installation of the speed hump will take approximately 90 days. The community can withdraw the request at anytime prior to installation.
