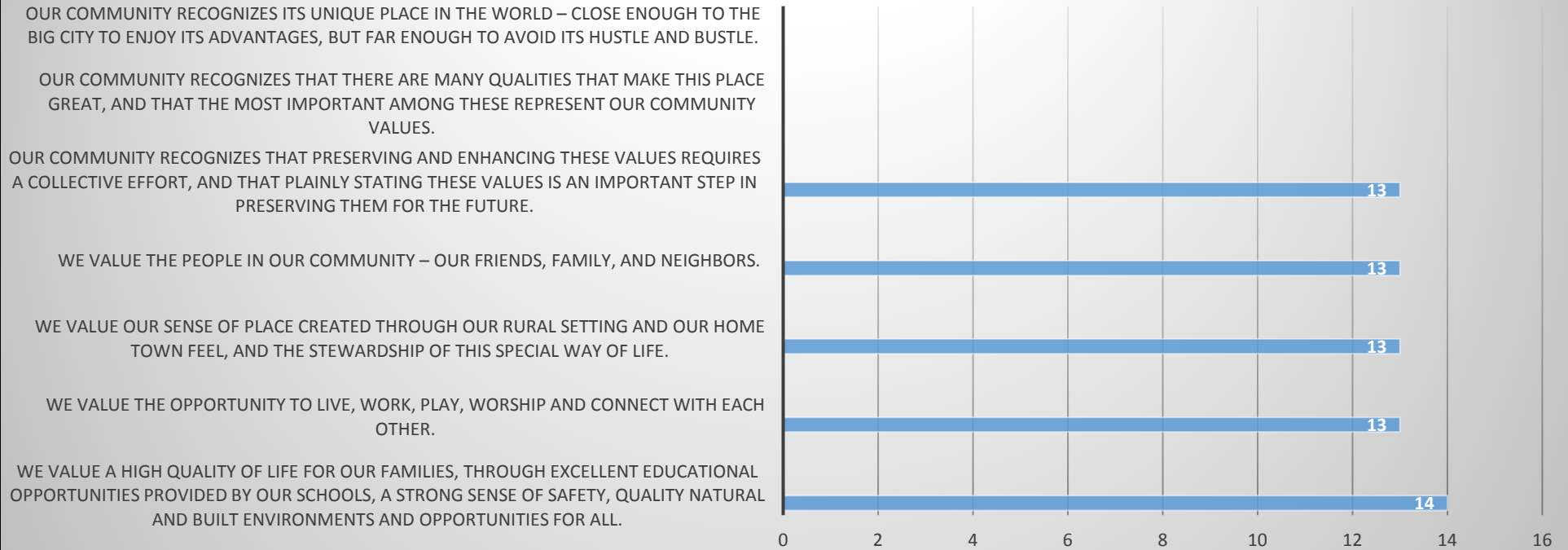

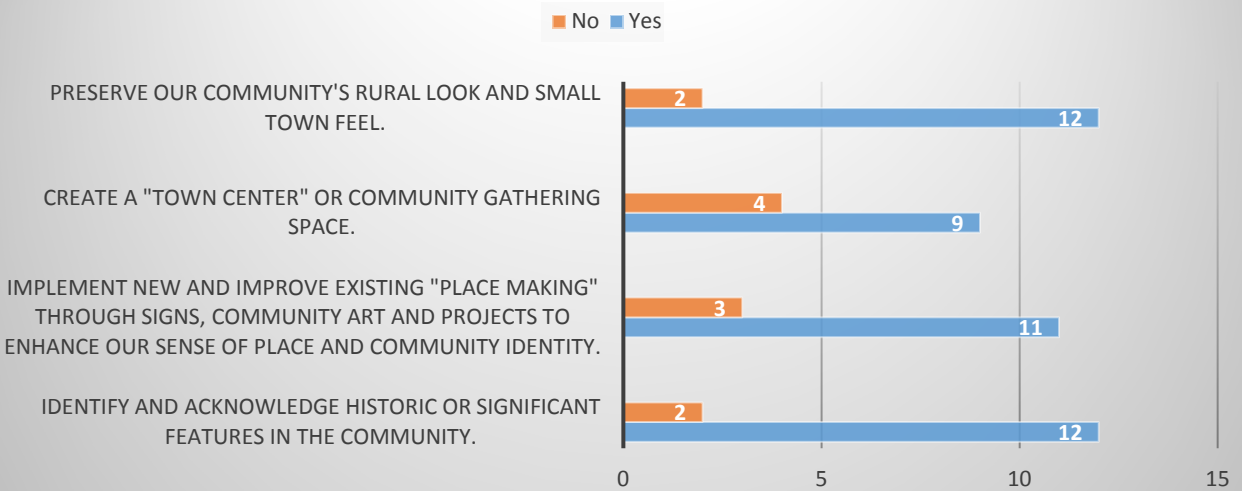
- Pave Hwy. 81

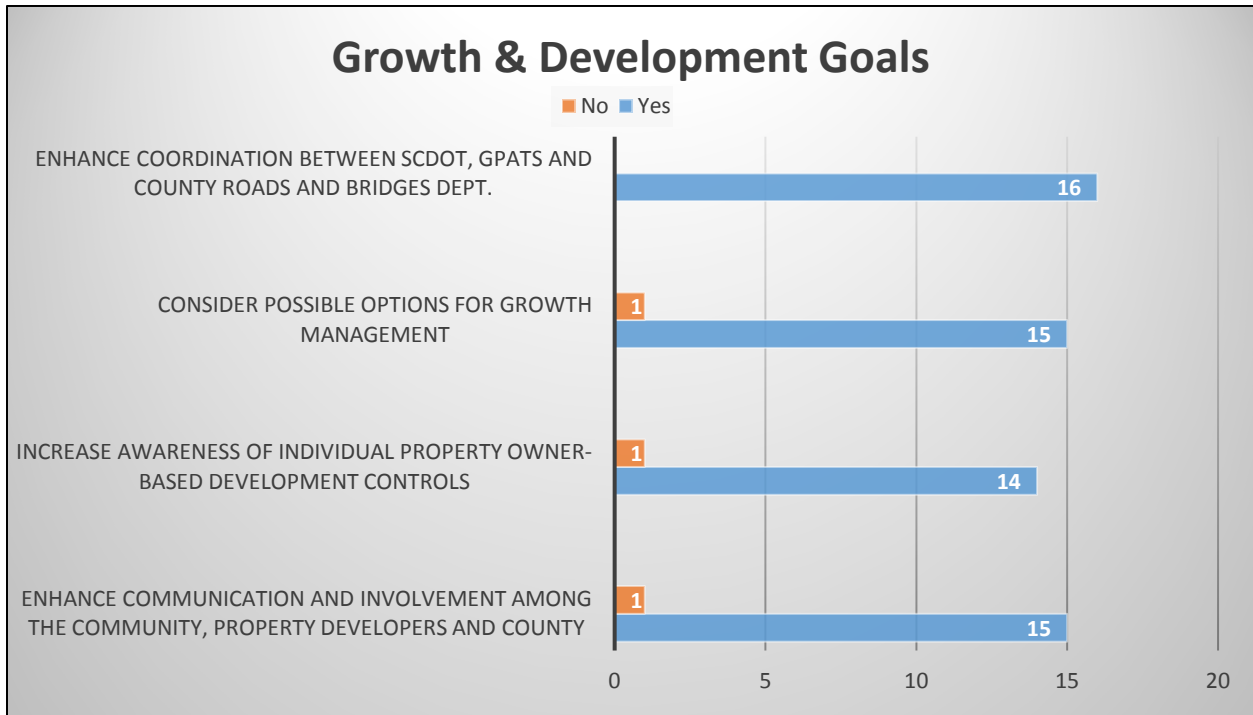
- Walkable business only
